## CRIMINAL EXPUNGEMENT CLINIC

Learn about the process of cleaning up your criminal record and receive assistance filling out the forms to start the process, including the fee waiver forms, for convictions in Sacramento County. If you bring your RAP sheet, we will help you understand how to read it. If you do not have a RAP sheet, you will need your XREF number.

## DEBTOR RIGHTS WORKSHOP

Learn about how credit works, how to make your credit score better, what debt collectors can and can't do when trying to get money from you, and your rights when you borrow money. We'll also give you information about how to avoid scams and what to watch out for when you're thinking about borrowing money. If you bring your credit report, we can help you learn how to read it, how to dispute errors, and how to clean up your report. This clinic is available at no cost to the public, regardless of income.

## TENANT RIGHTS WORKSHOP

Learn about your rights as a tenant throughout the process of renting a home, from application to moving out. **If you have been served with an eviction notice or an Unlawful Detainer (eviction lawsuit), we can offer you emergency legal assistance.** Please visit our website at [www.sacjustice.org](http://www.sacjustice.org) and fill out a contact form so that we can schedule you an appointment to talk to an attorney right away.

## FAMILY LAW CLINIC

Our Open Family Law Clinic is held twice a month on Fridays from 12-5 pm and is a first come, first serve clinic. There are volunteer attorneys available to assist with filling out paperwork and providing general information. We can assist with the paperwork for almost any family law matter, including:

- Domestic Violence Restraining Orders
- Divorce
- Child Custody
- Adoption
- Settlement Agreements
- Paternity
- Visitation

In order to participate in the clinic, it is suggested that you bring any paperwork you have in your case that has been filed with the court or that you have received from the other side.

## DIRECT LEGAL SERVICES

We offer direct legal representation to low-income individuals in the areas of family law, tenant defense/tenant rights, criminal record expungement, and civil rights. These services are available based upon the availability of attorneys. We also offer mediation services in family law matters to assist parties who wish to avoid going to court on a sliding scale basis.

## WHO IS ELIGIBLE?

In order to participate in our clinics or receive direct legal services, an individual's income must be within our guidelines (see reverse). Individuals who are income eligible for the California Superior Court Fee Waiver will receive free services; otherwise services are provided on a reduced, sliding scale basis .

**The Debtor Rights and Tenant Rights Workshops are available at no cost to anyone who attends, regardless of income.**

## CAN I VOLUNTEER?
